Third Stasis: Verses 132 - 176

Priest:

Look upon me, and be merciful to me, as is Your good pleasure toward those who love Your name. Order my steps according to Your promise, and let no iniquity have dominion over me. Deliver me from the false accusations of men, that I may keep Your precepts.

Refrain:

(Priest's note) Al - le - lu - ia

Make Your face to shine upon Your servant, and teach me Your statutes. My eyes shed streams of tears, because men do not keep Your law; thus are Your eyes toward me, and right are Your judgements.

Alleluia. (as above)

You have appointed Your testimonies and testimonies and in all faithfulness. My zeal consumes me, because my foes forget Your words; all your precepts I have tried in the fire, and Your servant loves it.

I am small and despised; do not forget Your precepts. Your righteousness is righteous forever, and Your law is truth; do not have come upon me, but Your commandments are my delight.

Your testimonies are righteous forever; give me understanding that I may live. I cry with my whole heart for me, O Lord; will keep Your statutes. I cry to You; save me, that I may observe Your testimonies.

I rise before dawn for help; I hope in Your words. My eyes are awake before the morning, that I may meditate upon Your promise. Hear my voice according to Your lovingkindness, O Lord; in Your judgment give me life.
